Description of the Index

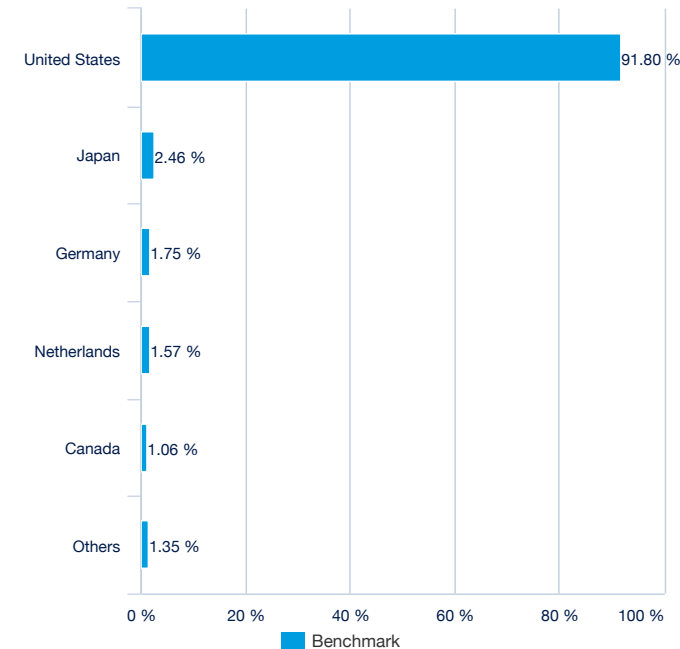

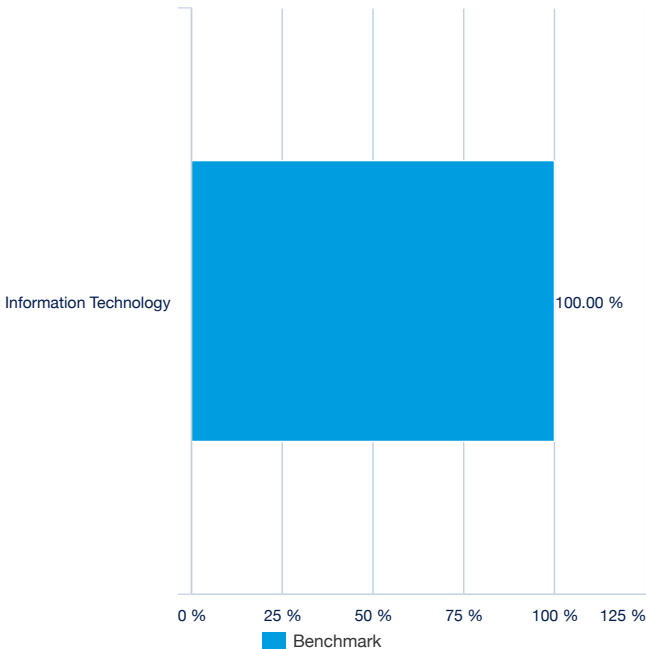
