
- Emerging markets are generally more sensitive to economic and political conditions than developed markets. 



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GLOSSARY

Price to Earnings: A valuation ratio of a company's current share price compared to its per-share earnings in the current forecast year, calculated as current share price divided by current earnings per share.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Price to Book Ratio: represents the ratio of the current closing price of the share to the latest quarter's book value per share.
