Investment objective:

The objective of the Sub-Fund is to achieve a long-term return in excess of the Benchmark by actively investing primarily in a portfolio of USD-denominated below investment grade corporate debt securities.

Investment policy:

The Sub-Fund pursues an actively-managed investment strategy.

Investment approach

- Uses a globally integrated research driven investment process that focuses on analysing fundamental, quantitative and technical factors across sectors and issuers.
- Bottom-up security selection approach based on assessing relative value across the USD-denominated developed market high yield issuers.

Investor profile:

This product is intended for investors who plan to stay invested for at least $\# \{RHP\}$ years.

- The Sub-Fund is intended for long-term investment. 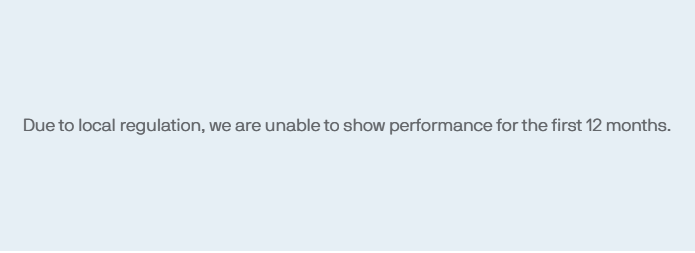

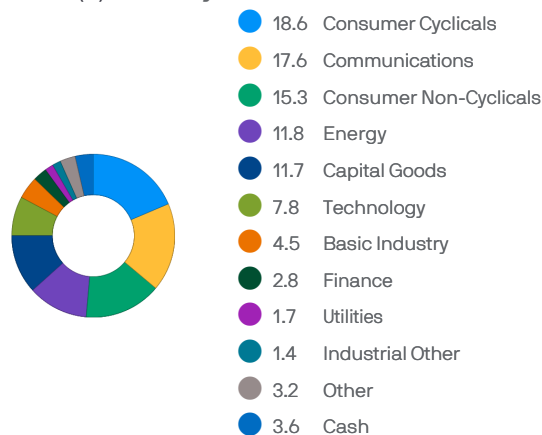
