Investment objective: The objective of the Sub-Fund is to achieve a long-term return in excess of the Benchmark by actively investing primarily in a portfolio of companies, globally, excluding the United States of America ("US").	
Investment policy: The Sub-Fund pursues an actively-managed investment strategy.	
Investment approach • Uses a fundamental, bottom-up stock selection process. • Enhanced index approach that builds a portfolio in reference to the benchmark by overweighting securities with the highest potential to outperform and underweighting securities considered most overvalued. • Diversified portfolio with disciplined, risk-controlled portfolio construction. • Applies values and norms based screening and implements minimum investment thresholds on companies with positive ESG characteristics.	
Investor profile: • Typical investors in the Sub-Fund are expected to be investors who want to take broad market exposure to global stock markets, excluding the US, who seek to benefit from potential excess returns with similar risks to investing in securities representing the Benchmark and who are prepared to accept the risks associated with an investment of this type, including the volatility of such market.

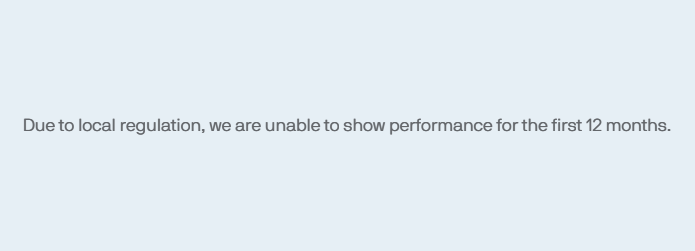

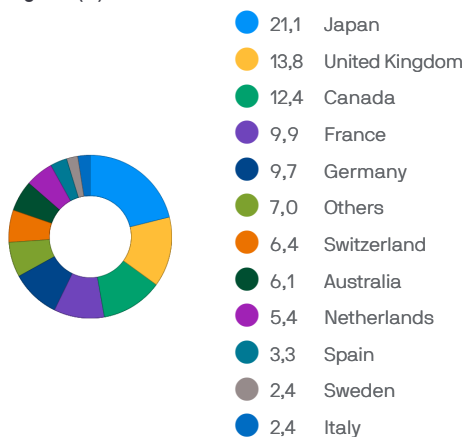

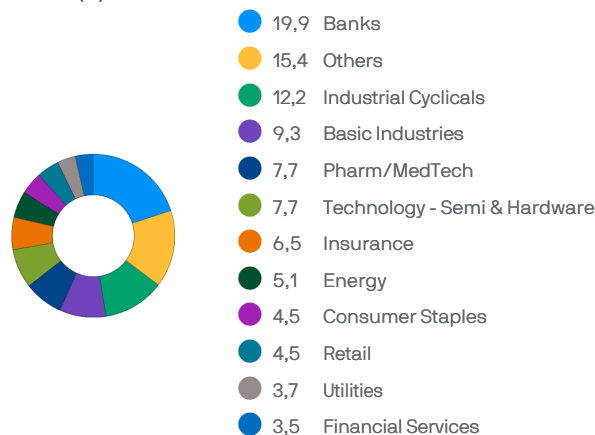

Key risks

For this reason, changes in currency exchange rates can affect the value of the Sub-Fund's portfolio and may impact the value of the Shares.

In respect of unhedged Share Classes in a currency other than the Base Currency of the Sub-Fund, the value of the Share Class will be subject to exchange risk in relation to the Base Currency of the Sub-Fund.

Sustainability risk is defined in the SFDR as "an environmental, social or governance event or condition that, if it occurs, could cause an actual or a potential material negative impact on the value of the investment". The Management Company considers sustainability risk as risks that are reasonably likely to materially negatively impact the financial condition or operating performance of an issuer and therefore the value of that investment. In addition, sustainability risk may increase the Sub-Fund's volatility and/ or magnify pre-existing risks to the Sub-Fund. Sustainability risk considerations are part of ESG Integration and the likely impacts of sustainability risks on the returns of the Sub-Fund are assessed in reference to the Investment Manager's approach to sustainability risk management in the Sub-Fund's investment process. For the Sub-Fund, sustainability risks are considered to have a lower likely impact on returns relative to other sub-funds under the ICAV. This is due to the sustainability risk mitigating nature of the relevant investment strategies. Investors should refer to the "Sustainability Risks" section of the Prospectus for further information.

The Sub-Fund seeks to provide a return above the Benchmark; however the Sub-Fund may underperform the Benchmark. Further information about risks can be found in the "Risk Information" section of the Prospectus.
