Fund Description

The PIMCO Advantage Euro Low Duration Corporate Bond UCITS ETF aims to generate maximum total return, consistent with prudent investment management. The Fund will invest primarily in an actively managed diversified portfolio of Euro denominated investment grade corporate Fixed Income Instruments.

Potential Investor Benefits

Enhanced Yield Potential: Short-dated corporate bonds offer a yield that is multiples higher than short-dated government bonds but with similar drawdown risk.

Attractive Risk-Adjusted Returns: Over the long term, low duration Euro credit can provide a higher return per unit of volatility compared to the full maturity credit market.

Potential Fund Advantage

PIMCO's Active Management Approach: The forward-looking, disciplined investment policy utilizes a top-down/bottom-up approach to assess relative value in different market environments.

Risk and Reward profile








Sector Allocation (%MV)



Maturity (%MV)




Duration (%DWE)




