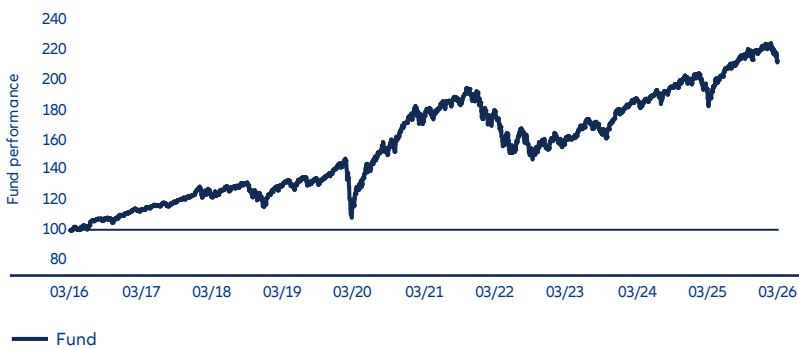

It is assumed that the bonds are held until maturity and interest income is reinvested on the same conditions.
