Investment Aim

The Fund seeks long-term total return (meaning capital growth and income) by investing primarily in a well-diversified portfolio of shares (or securities that are similar to shares). The companies issuing these shares have a registered office and official stock-market listing in Brazil, or carry out most of their business there. There aren't restrictions on the market values of the companies held in the fund. The Fund can also invest up to 10% of its assets in Real Estate Investment Trusts, up to 10% of its assets in collective investment schemes and up to 10% in a combination of convertible bonds and participation notes. 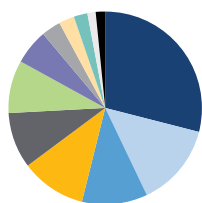
