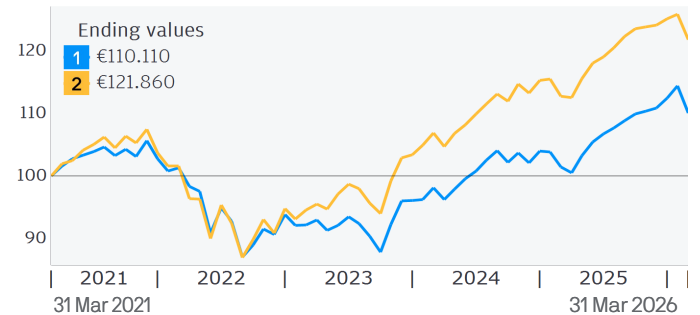

Definitions

NAV Net Asset Value of a fund's assets less its liabilities per Share.
