INVESTMENT POLICY OF THE FUND

The Fund is a total return investment fund that aims to create a portfolio consisting of bond-type assets through active portfolio management that achieves annualised capital growth for investors higher than the benchmark over a 3-year time horizon. It intends to achieve this objective primarily through asset allocation in global bond markets.

The Fund invests exclusively in bond-type instruments. The Fund's investment universe focuses on developed market government bonds, developed market corporate bonds, local currency emerging market government bonds and hard currency emerging market government and corporate bonds. The primary source of return for the Fund is asset allocation across bond-type asset classes. The asset allocation is based on an "investment clock" approach that uses economic data analysis to determine the position of major regions within a growth cycle. This is complemented by the forecasting of expected movements in real interest rates and inflation expectations, which are also crucial for the allocation across bond markets. Portfolio managers use all these as the basis for making allocation decisions, overweighting the best performing bond asset class in any current economic cycle based on experience and expectations. In the investment process, portfolio managers optimise the interest rate and credit risk of the overall fund and of the exposures to individual bond markets in order to achieve the investment objective.

MARKET SUMMARY

While global headlines remain fixated on the latest ceasefire rumours, the true economic fault line for emerging markets is the Strait of Hormuz. Until safe and predictable transit through this vital shipping lane resumes, the global economy isn't merely dealing with a spike in crude oil prices but rather absorbing a systemic supply shock that fuels widespread volatility and uncertainty. This reality marks a sharp and sudden departure from the highly supportive macro environment that kicked off the year, when robust growth, cooling inflation, and stable liquidity offered a comfortable backdrop. Since the crisis escalated in March, however, choked trade routes and disrupted commodity flows have simultaneously driven up inflationary pressures and dragged down economic momentum. Although investors still appear to be pricing in a rapid return to normal, history suggests that supply-side disruptions are notoriously persistent. While existing policy buffers and initial economic momentum have cushioned growth so far, the danger of these compounding costs bleeding deeply into the wider economy remains high, leaving emerging markets with deteriorating trade balances particularly vulnerable. After reducing exposure to the GCC and other markets most vulnerable to the conflict around Iran in March, we have begun selectively rebuilding positions. We have also moved to a neutral stance on emerging-market external debt, as valuations have become less attractive following the recent recovery.

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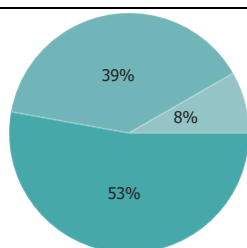

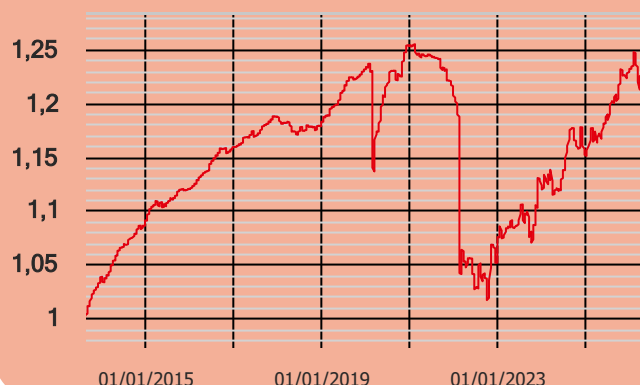
